Instructions: Complete steps 1-4 on the front and back of this form, return application and payment to address above.

## STEP 1: READ PARADE RULES & SIGN BELOW

1. All participants must enter at their pre-assigned location. This information will be mailed to you in early March. Check in as directed. Make sure you know your unit number and color!
2. Follow the directions and instructions given by the Parade Marshals.
3. Do not park cars or other vehicles that are not part of your unit(s) in the staging area. The Parade Marshals will direct you to alternative parking.
4. Parade units may perform for no more than 45 seconds in front of the reviewing stand. Instructions from Parade Marshals to resume movement must be followed immediately. Parade units are not allowed to stop and perform anywhere along the parade route as such performances disrupt the flow of the parade. All units must make a best effort to keep pace with the units ahead of them.
5. Drinking of alcohol by parade entrants is not permitted anywhere along the parade route.
6. As a safety precaution, no candy or other objects shall be thrown from parade unit. Items may be handed to children and other parade spectators by persons walking at the sides of the parade unit.
7. Participants shall clean up any materials or debris left in the staging area by your unit(s). This applies particularly (but not exclusively) to units with animals.
8. Parade units must continue moving until you have returned to the load-out area by Paul Brown Stadium parking lot. No stopping or unloading will be allowed prior to that as this will cause congestion and delays.
9. Owners of parade vehicles shall ensure that such vehicles are insured as required by State of Ohio law.
10. Drivers of motor vehicles must remain with the vehicle at all times.
11. Parade applicants shall clearly identify a person or persons in charge of their unit who may be contacted by Marshals or other Parade officials regarding parade rules violations.
12. Parade units violating any of these rules may, at the discretion of the Cincinnati St. Patrick Parade Committee, be disqualified from awards and denied entry in future parades.

**Entry & Advertising Release:** In consideration of acceptance of this entry, the entrant agrees to permit the Cincinnati St. Patrick Parade Committee, Inc. to use their names and/or photographs, films or tapes of the units for publicity, advertising and commercial promotion, before, during and after the event, and give permission to publish or sell or otherwise dispose of said photographs, films or tapes.

**Credentials:** Entry Confirmation will be made by return mail. All registration materials, and entrant identification will be issued by the Cincinnati St. Patrick Parade Committee.

**Liability:** In consideration of the acceptance of the right to participate in the Cincinnati St. Patrick's Day Parade, by execution of this entry form, I, my organization and related participants or entrants (hereinafter referred to collectively as is Entrant), hereby release and discharge the Cincinnati St. Patrick Parade Committee, Inc., its officers, directors, employees, representatives and anyone else connected with management of the St. Patrick's Day Parade from any and all known or unknown damages, injuries, losses, judgment and or claims from any cause whatsoever that may be suffered by any Entrant to his/her person or property. Further, each Entrant and/or each member or participant of the Entrants organization expressly agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Cincinnati St. Patrick's Parade Committee, Inc., its directors, employees, representatives, and anyone else connected with management or presentation of the Cincinnati St. Patrick's Day Parade, from any and all liability including attorney fees and cost resulting from the actions or conduct of Entrant's guests, Entrant's entry or unit, whether it be motor powered, animal or animal drawn or otherwise, or any participant assisting or cooperating with Entrant, whether at the direction or control of Entrant, or not under said control or direction.
